
Food Receipts and Distribution

Pounds Distributed

- 2014-15 1Q distribution = 4,007,284 pounds
- 2013-14 1Q distribution = 3,081,321 pounds
- *This is a 30% increase.*

Key Points:

- **National Manufacturers** refers primarily to the food that we receive off of Feeding America's Choice System. The main reason for the decline in this type of food is that we were not actively pursuing it in the first quarter.
- **National Donors with Local Presence** refers primarily to retailers like Walmart, Sam's Club, Food Lion, and BI-LO. The BI-LO program was in its first few months last year at this time. It has grown to providing more than 79,000lbs of food this past quarter, much of which was picked up directly by our agencies. Beginning in 2015 Sam's Club stores will begin donating produce. This is expected to create another significant increase in our retail program moving forward.
- One of the most notable happenings in donations from our **Local** sources these past few months was a summer tomato frenzy. Flavor 1st donated 437,850 pounds of produce in the first quarter. Most of that was fresh tomatoes, some of which we sent to our partner food banks.
- The **SNAP** decline is attributed to timing of the spending. We are spending later this year than previous year due to changes in timing with the state contract.
