
Attention: SNAP Time Limits Are Temporarily Suspended During State of Emergency

The Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) passed by the US Congress temporarily suspends work requirements for **Able-Bodied Adults Without Dependents (ABAWDs)** during this pandemic. *ABAWDs are adults between 18-49 without children who are able to work.*

Starting April 1, 2020, the SNAP work requirements for ABAWDs will be suspended in **EVERY STATE**. No one will be required to work 20 hours a week (80 hours a month) in order to keep receiving SNAP.
