Your Part



We urge anyone who is high-risk, uncomfortable or unvaccinated to stay home and stay safe.



Bring your own face covering or mask. *Required by all*, regardless of vaccination status.

Wear closed-toed shoes.

Arrive 5 minutes before your scheduled shift. Use your mobile device to sign in for your shift (alternative sign-in options available if needed).



Wash your hands immediately upon entering the building. Sanitize hands regularly while on-site.

Do your best to maintain a social distance of 6 feet whenever possible.

At MANNA, we:

Diligently **clean and sanitize** the Volunteer Center prior to and after every volunteer shift.

Have reduced the max number of volunteers on each shift, and increased our space for volunteer projects.

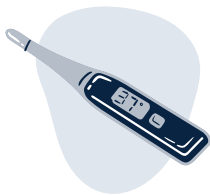
Require everyone entering the building to wear a facemask while on premises.
